

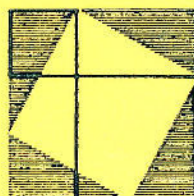

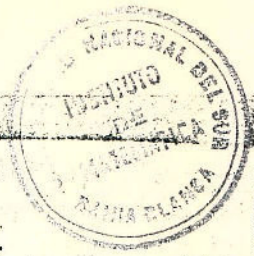

Estimado Dr. Malek:

Tengo el agrado de dirigirme a Ud., en nombre del Comité Latinoamericano de la Sociedad Bernoulli para la Estadística Matemática y la Probabilidad, para solicitar su colaboración a los efectos de poner en marcha un programa de asistencia bibliográfica a los estudiosos de la disciplina en nuestra región.-

En virtud de las grandes carencias que se observan en este aspecto, en la mayoría de los países de la América Latina y el Caribe, nuestra Sociedad ha decidido impulsar la constitución de bibliotecas básicas, que contengan no más de alrededor de trescientos volúmenes y que sirvan a los grupos incipientes para su formación y estudio.-

Merced a la colaboración desinteresada y eficiente de nuestros colegas de la Universidad del Sur, en Bahía Blanca, Argentina, los Profesores Nélida Winzer y Edgardo Fernández-que han elaborado la bibliografía adjunta, contamos con una descripción detallada de necesidades. Se trata de un conjunto equilibrado y pequeño que pone el acento en los aspectos de formación, y en una cierta diversificación temática e idiomática, en la teoría y en sus aplicaciones.-

El costo de cada biblioteca es del orden de 8.000 dólares americanos, aunque este monto está obviamente sujeto a fluctuaciones cambiarias y de precio, que pueden ser sensibles.-

Nuestro deseo sería el de establecer, en una primera etapa, cinco de tales bibliotecas, para apoyar algunos de los Grupos de Trabajo existentes que afrontan graves carencias. Para el futuro en caso de extenderse en

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el tiempo, se requiere una actualización periódica del sistema, tanto en lo referente al conjunto de títulos como al costo.

Agradeciendo desde ya su atención a este planteamiento, así como la colaboración de UNESCO para nuestro proyecto, saludo al señor Director con mi consideración más distinguida.-
